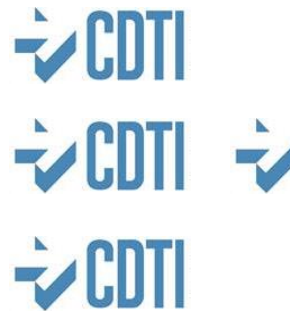

# Funding of Spanish participants – CoD14

- **Project Start date:** February - November 2021
- **Latest end date:** January 2024 (including any extensions needed after the approval of the project)
- **Grant:** up to **60%** small enterprises, **50%** medium sized, **40%** large companies  
**75% of the grant is paid in advance** every year, remaining 25% after justification of expenses
- **How?** *Convocatoria Interempresas Internacional = CIIP*
  - Official national funding call according to Spanish regulation on grants
  - Call is open immediately after the endorsement of projects – during 10 working days
  - 1 application for each Spanish participant in Spanish to justify the budget. **NO** additional technical evaluation
- **Participant´s budget:** cannot be higher than the budget in the Eurostars application
- **Non-fundable tasks:**
  - Dissemination, entry into market, commercialization. End users not involved in R&D tasks (TRL>6)
  - Management Work Packages (management costs can be included in technical WP)

# What can be funded to Spanish participants?

<b>Personnel costs</b>	Technical staff and 58 hours/month for project management
<b>Overheads</b>	≤ 25% of personnel costs
<b>Travel</b>	≤ 8.000€ per participant along the whole project
<b>Materials</b>	Consumables (purchase cost) & equipment (depreciation cost)
<b>Other</b>	Audit costs ≤ 2.000€ per financial year
<b>Subcontracting</b>	Technical subcontracting << 50% total

There is **no maximum nor minimum budget or grant** established by the national funding call
